

Dear Parents,

Due to the closure of schools, we are making it easier for your children to participate in Online Learning and share this with their class teachers. We will be using Seesaw to assign activities and message children with Learning By Question codes.

Seesaw is a secure online journal where students can document and reflect on what they are learning at home. Your child will be able to add the things we would like them to work on (including photos, videos, worksheets, drawings and voice recordings) to their Seesaw journal. Each child will have a unique login and they will be able to view only the work they have uploaded and teachers assigned to that class will be able to view the work and mark from home.

In order for your child to use Seesaw, the app needs your child's name (we have only used their first name and perhaps an initial of surname) in order to be able to associate work like their photos, videos or voice recordings with their account. Seesaw only uses this information to provide the service and doesn't advertise in Seesaw, create profiles of students, or share or sell your child's personal information or journal content.
