### **PE & Sport Premium Strategy 2019-2020**

#### **What is the Primary School PE & Sport Premium?**

The government has allocated extra funding to all primary schools to improve Physical Education (PE) and Sport so that they develop pupils' healthy lifestyles. This has been continued into the 2019-2020 financial year.

#### **What should it be used for?** Schools may choose how they use the funding, for example to:

- Hire specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches to work with primary teachers during PE lessons
- Support and involve the least active children, talented children and children who do not have the opportunity to attend clubs, by running after-school sports clubs
- Provide resources and training courses in PE and sport for teachers
- Offer children new sporting experiences.

#### **How we will make sure these improvements are sustainable?**

- Teachers will be expected to observe sports coaches / sports partnership experts in order to develop their skills at least once a term.
- The PE subject leader will monitor PE sessions at least once a year or team teach with individual staff to develop their skills.

In 2019-2020 We will receive £16,360 for the PE and Sport Premium.
