Together we will:-

- Support your child and help them to achieve their potential within a Christian environment of Faith, Love and Forgiveness.

As a parent I will try to:-

- Make sure our child arrives at school before 9.00 a.m.
- Avoid taking holidays in term time.
- Notify the school when our child is absent and provide a reason for the absence as soon as is practicable.
- Support the school in matters of discipline, uniform, jewellery and medication and advise the school of any health or relevant family problems.
- Encourage reading through the hearing of reading and the sharing of different types of books, possibly through joining the library.
- Meet with staff to discuss progress as Open Evenings and work with the teacher to address any worries should they arise.
- Ensure homework is completed to the best of my child's ability.
- Participate in some of the P.T.F.A. events during the year.

- Read newsletters, texts and other literature sent from school.
- Provide practical support to the school when possible - e.g. helping on school trips.

As a school we will try to:-

- Maintain a high standard of teaching at all times.
- Provide a broad and balanced curriculum to meet the needs of your child.
- Provide a safe and happy environment in which your child can strive to achieve the best they can.
- Be open and welcoming wherever possible and offer opportunities for you to become involved in school life.
 - Provide newsletters to keep you informed of school events.
 - Provide regular homework that builds on work undertaken in school.
 - Celebrate achievements through various award systems.
 - Encourage high standards of behaviour at all times.
- Provide regular opportunities for parents to meet with staff to discuss the progress made by the children.

As a child I will try to:-

- Listen to my teacher and do my work to the best of my ability.
- Work quietly and sensibly and do as I am told, when asked.
 - Be polite and helpful and avoid using bad language.
 - Take care of the school and all I use in it.
 - Avoid distracting other children in my class.
 - Treat others in the way I would like them to treat me.
 - Do my homework and hand it in on time.
 - Arrive on time at school.
- Talk to my teacher if I am worried or concerned about something.
 - Take all letters home and give them to a parent/guardian.
