Have a lovely 2 week half term after next week , let's hope the weather holds!

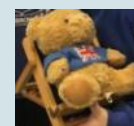
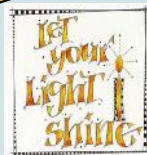

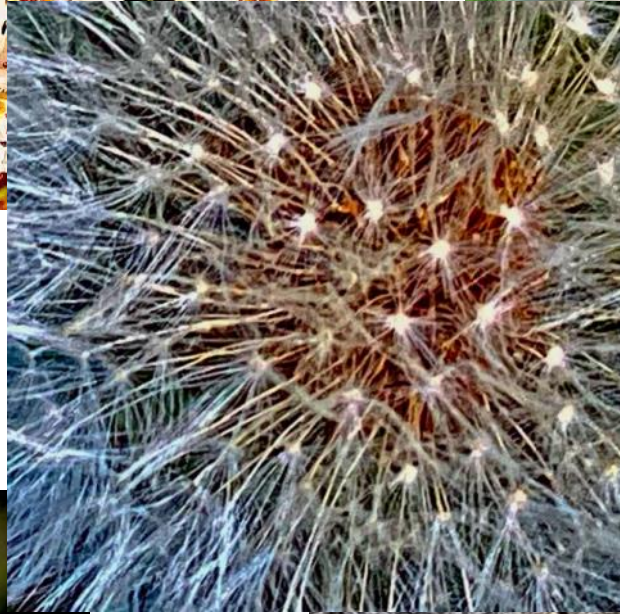
